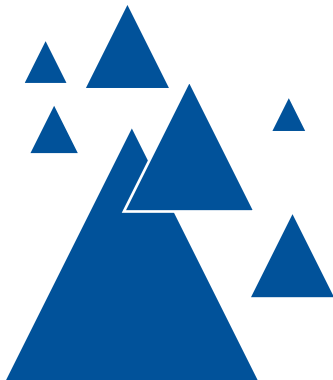
ICAS will be hosting the Programme and a number of Professors will be on hand to discuss your proposals or more fully developed pieces of research. In addition, the Programme will include:
